I am very glad to present the Annual Report of Govt. Degree College, Kodur on the eve of the 37th College Annual Day Celebrations.

The College was established in the year 1983 with the sincere and persistent efforts of some great people of this town. Initially, B. A. and B. Com Courses were started. Later, with the effort of the College Committee, B.Sc. Courses with BZC and MPC groups were started during the year 1993-1994. The College Committee also provided separate Laboratories for four Science Departments. The courses B. Sc. Computer Science, and B. Com Computer Applications were started from the academic year 2001-2002. At present, all the Laboratories are fully equipped with sufficient accommodation.

College Planning and Development Council:

The College Planning and Development Council were constituted as per the norms of the Government. The Secretary and all the members of the CPDC are actively participating in all the development programmes, functioning in the College.

College Campus:

The College campus is situated at K. Buduguntapalli of Kodur. The College campus is about 9.17 acres and was donated by the family members of Late. Sri Rachaputi Govinda Rao of K. Buduguntapalli and all the buildings for Classrooms, Laboratories and Offices were constructed with the Government and UGC funds.

Accreditation by NAAC:

The college had been granted U.G.C. recognition under 12 B & 2 F categories on 01-02-1992 and 20-11-1994 respectively. The College was accredited by NAAC during the year 2007 with B+ Grade. Recently, the College went NAAC Re-Accreditation. The NAAC Peer team visited the College

for Re-Accreditation Evaluation on 5th& 6th of December in 2014. We proudly announce that our College secured “B” grade with 2.35 CGPA score. I am conveying my sincere thanks to Teaching, Non teaching, Students, CPDC and one and all who gave their extreme co-operation in the NAAC Re-Accreditation process.

Infrastructural Facilities:

1. All the Departments are provided with Internet facility under NME Scheme which is helpful to the Students and Staff for updating their knowledge.
2. RO water purifier is installed in the campus to provide purified drinking water to the students and staff under UGC College Development Assistance Grants.
3. Two Blue star water coolers are installed in the campus with UGC funds.
4. Library is automated with SOUL 2.0 Software with UGC funds. Office is also automated with Office Automation software with UGC funds.
5. Two LCD projectors were procured to improve teaching learning facility with UGC financial grants.
6. Fiber net based Virtual Class room was established to provide Online classes to the students.
7. Three Digital Classrooms are being used by all the Departments to provide the Students a Technology – based education.

Jawahar Knowledge Centre:

Srilakshmi, Lecturer in Computer Applications to train the students in Communication and Soft skills, Analytical skills and Computer skills to face Interviews for Job recruitment in various Firms. Smt. G. P. Asha Latha, Lecturer in English is the JKC GEM (Guest English Mentor) for the JKC classes.

Our students attended Mega Job Mela on 24th of September in 2019 at Chedalavada Ramanamma Engineering College, Tirupati. The Job Mela was conducted by CSS Group from Tamil Nadu in Ndetworking.

Remedial classes:

Remedial Classes are being conducted for backlog Students in all subjects by all the Lecturers to uplift the standards of the Students. Even the Slow and Moderate Learners are given remedial coaching.

Provision of Open University Study Centre:

In view of getting benefit to the discontinued students of this locality, this college is providing accommodation for Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University Study Centre to educate them. In the Co-ordination of Sri G. Ravi Teja, Lecturer in Zoology of the College, the classes of the Study Centre for various subjects are running in a smooth manner and every year many students get through their examinations and become qualified.

Provision of AP Skill Development Corporation:

Our college was one of the Centres of AP Skill Development Corporation in the Co-ordination of Smt. K. Uma Maheswari, Lecturer in Computer Science. But, at present, the Skill Development Centre has been shifted to DLTC /ITI, Kadapa on 17th of December, 2019.
